

Immigration at a Glance

In the last 30 years, Congress has *tripled* legal immigration levels;

The U.S. admits more than 1 million legal aliens annually, the highest sustained rate in U.S. history;

More than 300,000 illegal aliens settle permanently in the U.S. each year;

More than 25% of federal prison inmates are aliens;

More than 72,000 aliens are arrested each year for drug offenses in the U.S.;

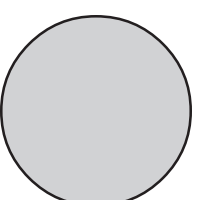
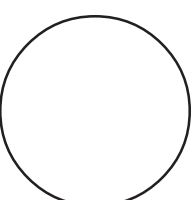
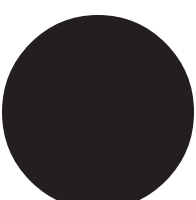
America's net costs from immigration will reach \$80 billion a year by 2004;

More than 90 % of today's immigrants are from the Third World;

Immigrants with the right skin color who never lived in the U.S. are entitled to affirmative action benefits after they arrive.

The U.S. Census Bureau reports that increasing numbers of people in the U.S. speak a language other than English at home. The nation gained more immigrants in the 1990's -- 13.3 million -- than in any previous decade. Because of that foreign cultural influence, more than 10.5 million U.S. residents speak little or no English in the home, up from 6.5 million in 1990. Of all school-age children, 18 percent (9.8 million) do not speak English at home. Of those, 70 percent speak Spanish.

An unprecedented tidal wave of immigration from Latin America, Asia, and Africa is changing the U.S. from a nation of mostly European descendants to a nation of mostly Latin, Caribbean, and Third World people.

“The shift is well under way,” reported Heather Dewar of Knight Ridder News Service. “If it continues at its current pace, by the time today’s toddlers reach middle age, every American will be a member of a minority group.”

“We’ve never had this kind of diversity before, and neither has anybody else,” said sociologist Philip Nlyden of Loyola University. “The big question is, what kind of society is America going to be?”

Unfortunately, the American people have never been asked whether they want to discard America’s unique heritage in favor of a vague multiculturalism.

Instead, America’s leaders have decided to impose it.

“We want to to become a multiracial, multiethnic society,” said President Bill Clinton in 1997. At a White House meeting with journalists, the president described overturning America’s traditions through

immigration as “a great revolution” that “will prove we literally can live without. . . having a dominant European culture.”

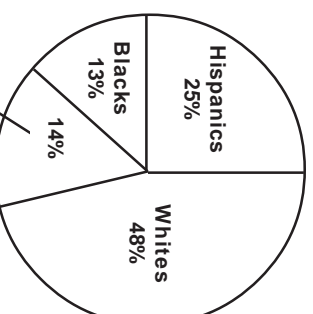
Give or take a decade at current immigration rates, Americans of European descent will be reduced to less than half of the population.

Immigrants and their descendants will constitute the majority of the U.S. population.

That means America’s 300 year-old European-derived culture is not likely to survive. More than 90 percent of the immigration fueling this Third World where the customs, habits, and values of the people are

radically different from America’s historic cultural pattern.

Current immigration flows are the result of policies adopted by Congress from 1965 to 1996. Congress not only increased legal immigration by 40 percent, but granted amnesty to roughly 4 million illegal aliens.

Today, nearly 1.3 million legal and illegal aliens settle permanently in the U.S. each year. Immigrants and their children already account for more than half of America’s entire annual population growth, driving the U.S. population from 285 million today to 400 million by 2050.

Immigrants are already a potent political force in elections and legislation. As ethnic advocacy groups and their political allies organize these foreign populations, America’s heritage of individual liberty is being dismantled in favor of group rights, racial quotas, and multiculturalism.

Open immigration fosters the growth of colonies of foreign-speaking peoples where potential terrorist groups can operate and make plans. Each of the 19 suicide hijackers responsible for the Sept. 11 attacks was admitted to the U.S. legally.

In addition, overcrowding, environmental degradation, unemployment, ethnic conflict and radical political change are the result of uncontrolled immigration.

Unless America reverses course, the heritage and identity of our country will be permanently changed.
